



Thrive Nursery offers a one-time (per purchased tree) warranty on our trees. The warranty is for 50% of the original purchase price of the tree/s, and it is for a full calendar year from the date the tree/s was purchased. The dead tree must be brought back, along with purchase receipt to redeem warranty.

The product's purchase receipt MUST be presented to redeem warranty! (Keep your receipt, we do not keep records of your purchases).

Thrive Nursery does not warranty perennials, grasses, shrubs, or discounted/b-grade trees. We will not warranty any tree/s planted in a USDA cold hardiness zone not suited to the tree/s' cold hardiness zone.

In addition, we do not warranty any tree/s damaged by environmental and non-environmental hazards (i.e. wind damage or weed whip trunk damage). We also will not warranty any B&B tree where the burlap and wire basket were completely removed (see reverse side for planting guide). Thrive Nursery does not warranty any plants obtained through a landscape contractor.



Dwarf Norway Spruce 'Sherwood Compact'

Plant this narrow spruce where it's strongly ascending branches can serve as a specimen in a small space that need big impact. 'Compacta' can also be used as a small privacy/screening wall.





Weeping Norway Spruce 'Pendula'

Weeping Norway Spruce can be staked and trained into an outstanding upright specimen, or it can be allowed to grow as an undulating groundcover that will drape over slopes and walls. Plant a row of them with stakes and wire supports to train into a living fence.



Engelmann Spruce 'Bush's Lace'

'Bush's Lace' is a vigorous growing form of Engelmann spruce. With a strong central leader, its branches extend out before drooping downward. Unique in that, although the branching is a bit irregular, it still makes a stately presence in the garden. Engelmann spruce is native to the higher elevations of the Rocky and Cascade Mountains and is adapted to dealing with extreme winds and cold.

The magnificent, formal *Picea omorika* 'Gotelli Weeping' adds height and drama to any garden. It shares the lovely two-tone appearance with the species, and it tolerates heat and humidity better than most. This tree's beauty and weeping character increase with time and maturity.

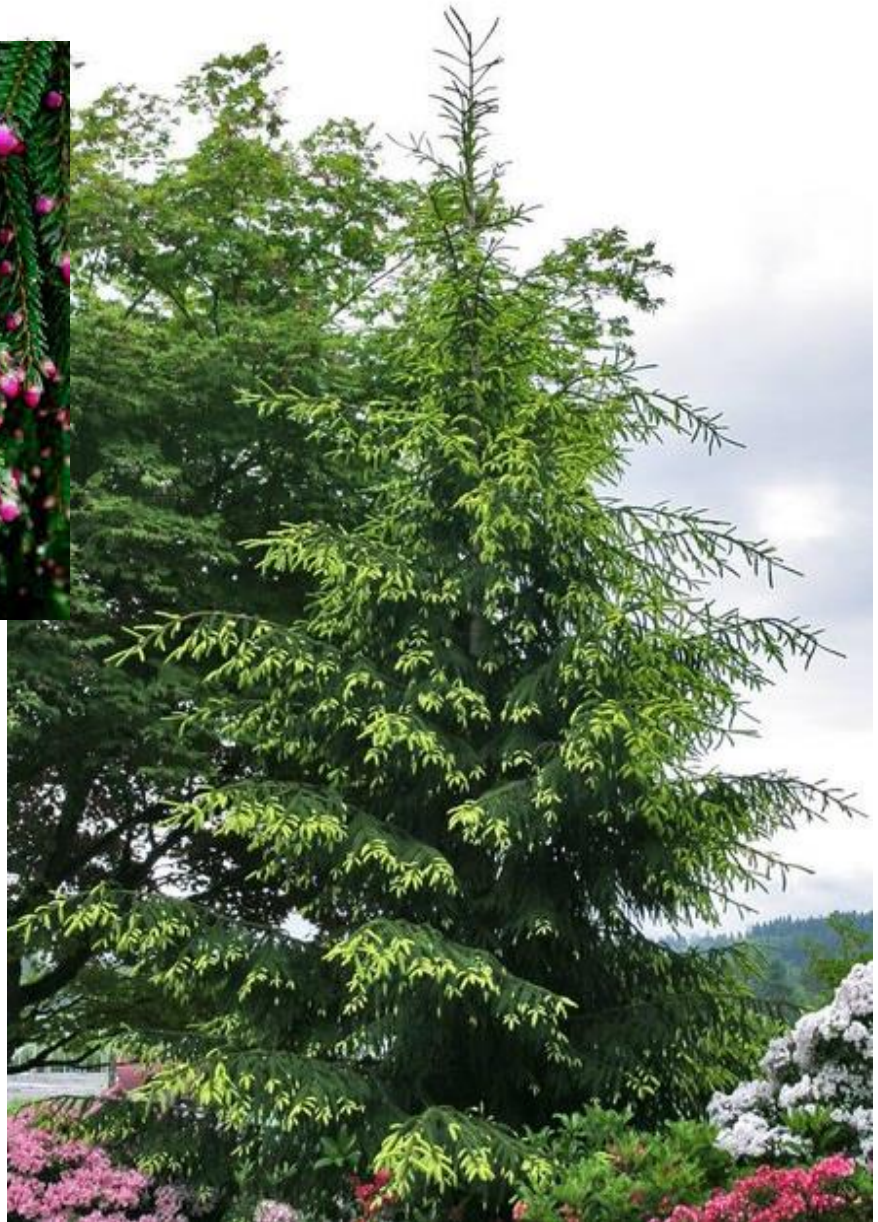

Very short, glossy, dark green needles, held close to the stems of *Picea orientalis* 'Gowdy' give the well-defined, recurved, sweeping branch, oriental spruce a distinctive appearance. The soft-to-the-touch spruce develops into a stately accent that stands out among other greens in the landscape.

This beautiful selection produces bright, spring-green new growth that quickly matures to one of the darkest, richest greens in the conifer world. Short, closely held, shiny, green needles cover the tree's ascending, rigid branches. When young, 'Shadow's Broom' frequently displays a funnel-like center. As it matures, it becomes a broad, mounding specimen. Use this spruce in smaller spaces instead of the spider mite prone dwarf Alberta Spruce.



Weeping White Spruce 'Slenderina'

More upright than prostrate, this blue spruce has a graceful upward, yet weeping habit and a strong electric blue color. Average growth rate in Utah is 6-8 inches per year; no pruning or shaping is required. Slenderina creates a spectacular specimen in the landscape.



Columnar Austrian Pine 'Green Tower'

A slow-growing upright evergreen conifer with a dense pillar-like form. Lush green needles in fascicles of two. Provides a nice green exclamation point to the landscape, as well as making a great evergreen screen. As shown in the picture, green tower also makes a great evergreen center piece in containers.



Ponderosa Pine
Pinus ponderosa

Ponderosa pine trunks grow to 4' in diameter. Dark yellow-green needles in bundles of three are concentrated in tufts at the branch ends. Oval cones grow upright, then turn upside down at maturity to release seed. Bark on mature trees is bright yellowish-brown to reddish-orange.



Arizona Cypress 'Raywood's Weeping'

'Raywood's Weeping' is an interesting addition to temperate gardens as each plant has a unique form. Arms that extend out from a staked central leader weave and curl, creating a conversation piece for garden visitors. White specks are scattered along the fine, delicate, blue green foliage.



Arizona Cypress 'Chaparral'

Chaparral Arizona Cypress has attractive grayish green foliage which emerges powder blue in spring. The threadlike leaves are highly ornamental and remain grayish green throughout the winter. Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant. The peeling reddish bark is extremely showy and adds significant winter interest. A broadly pyramidal accent tree, with graceful branching; use as a solitary accent in the yard or a large garden; an excellent screen or windbreak; highly heat and drought tolerant once established.

With a slower growth rate than other popular cultivars, this variety can develop to its full majesty in many sizes of landscapes.

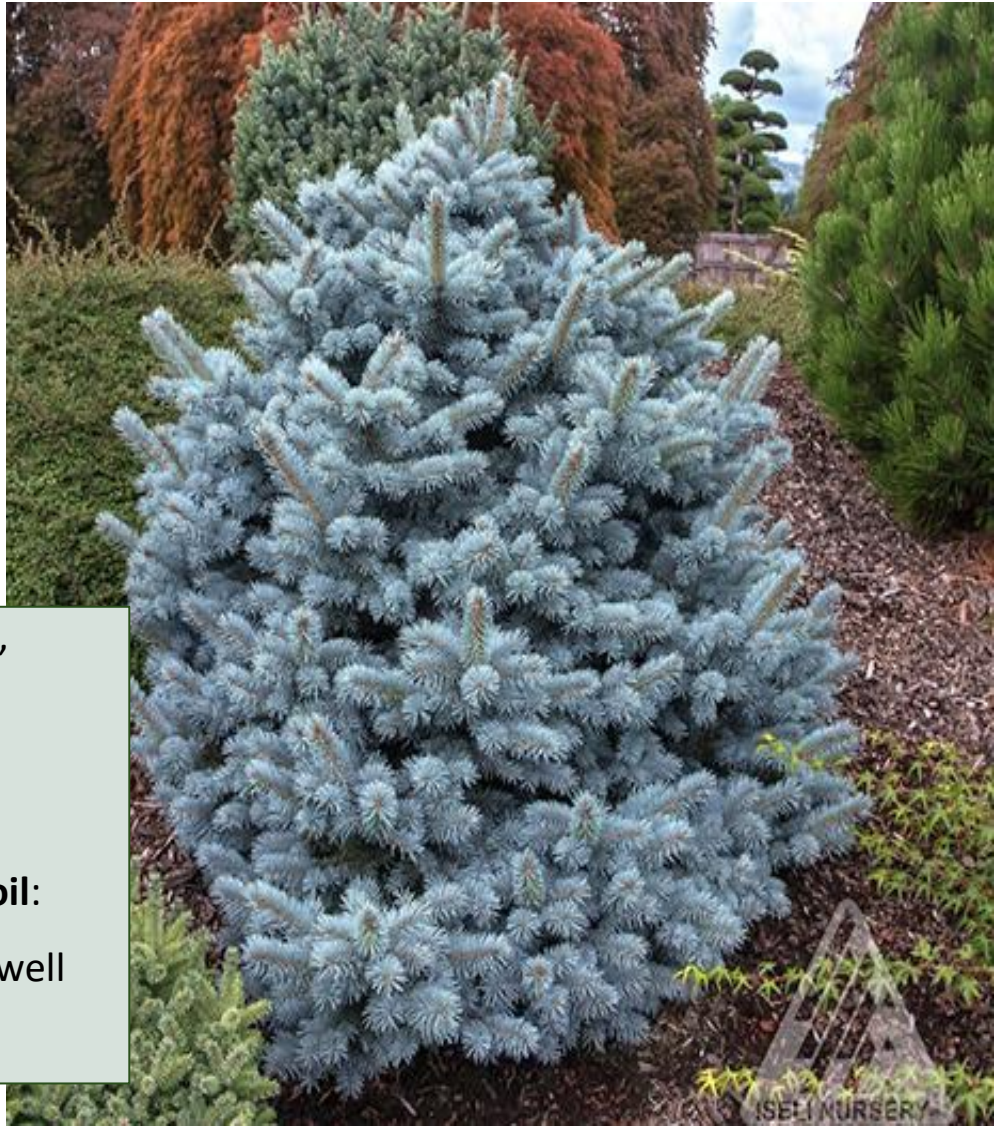

Blue, gem-like color combined with a slow rate of growth makes *Picea pungens* 'Zafiro' suited for gardens with limited space. It has the outstanding lush blue needles of its parent, P.p. 'Moerheim' but differs in size and habit from other selections with much slower growth and a rounded profile. This compact dwarf tree is an excellent alternative choice to the generic "Dwarf Blue Globe Spruce" commonly specified in suburban landscapes.
